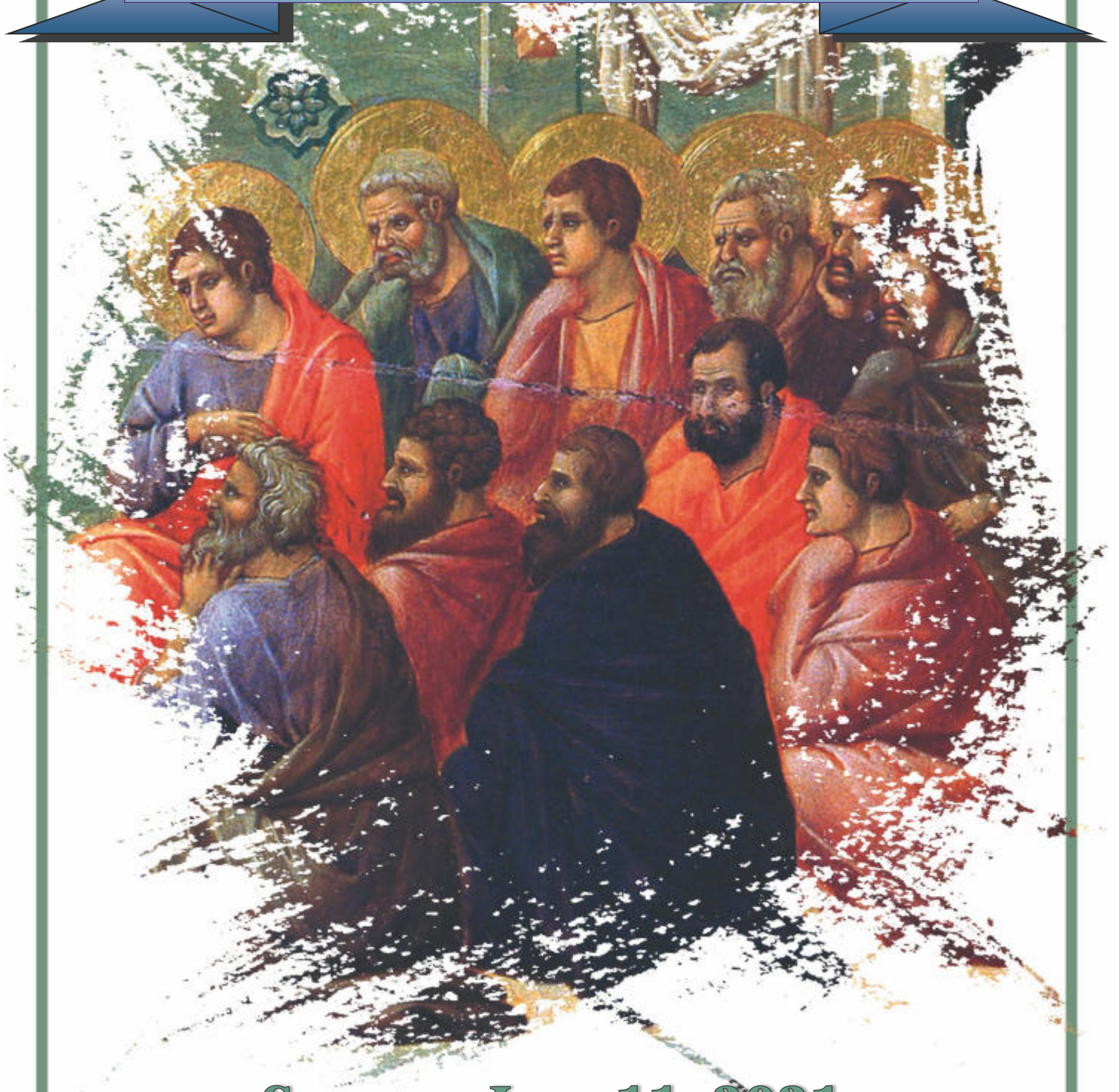

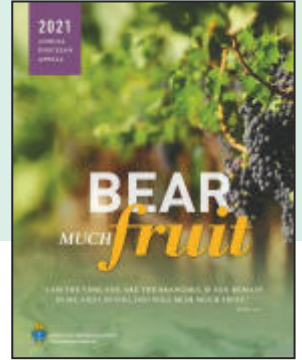

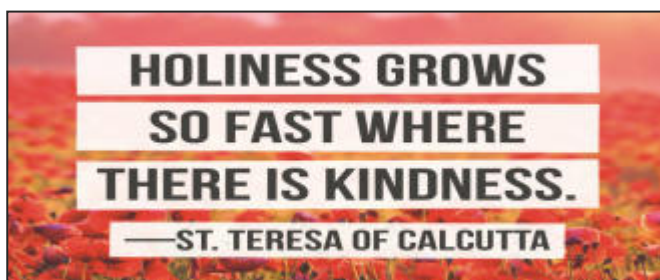

INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

God calls us to bring His Word to all corners of the earth.

What does that mean for you and me? We are just simple and humble folks trying to find our way through the Gospel and our world. After all, we are not professional preachers but gentle servants. Jesus summons us to take His message on the road and bring it from the pew to the pavement. **We cannot keep the joy of the Gospel to ourselves but must bring it into every aspect of our lives: our families, our schools, our work, our corporations, our politics, our social circles, and our philosophies.** We cannot just accept the wisdom of the world as true and conduct our lives as if the Good News is a separate matter.
