In years past, our Women's Ministry depended on the assistance of The Salvation Army and other service organizations for their annual rummage sale.

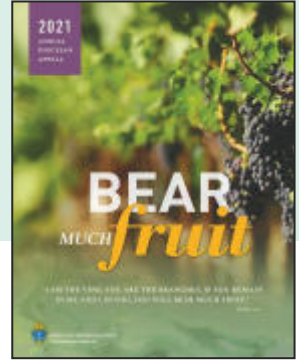

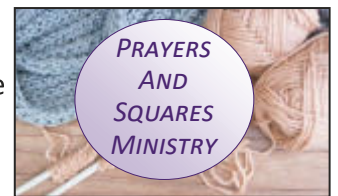
