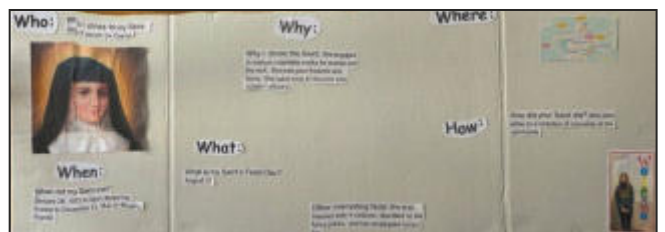
This week let's meet Evelyn Czarnik!
