This week let's meet Tyler Sepsey!

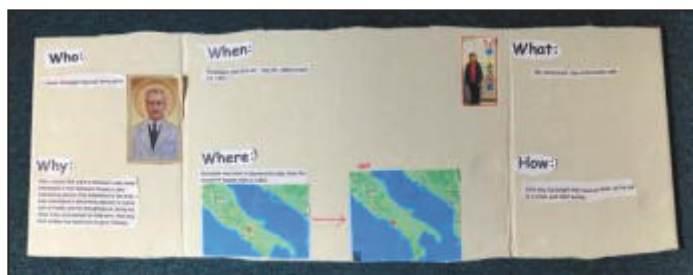
Tyler is a student in 8th grade at Nippersink Middle School.
