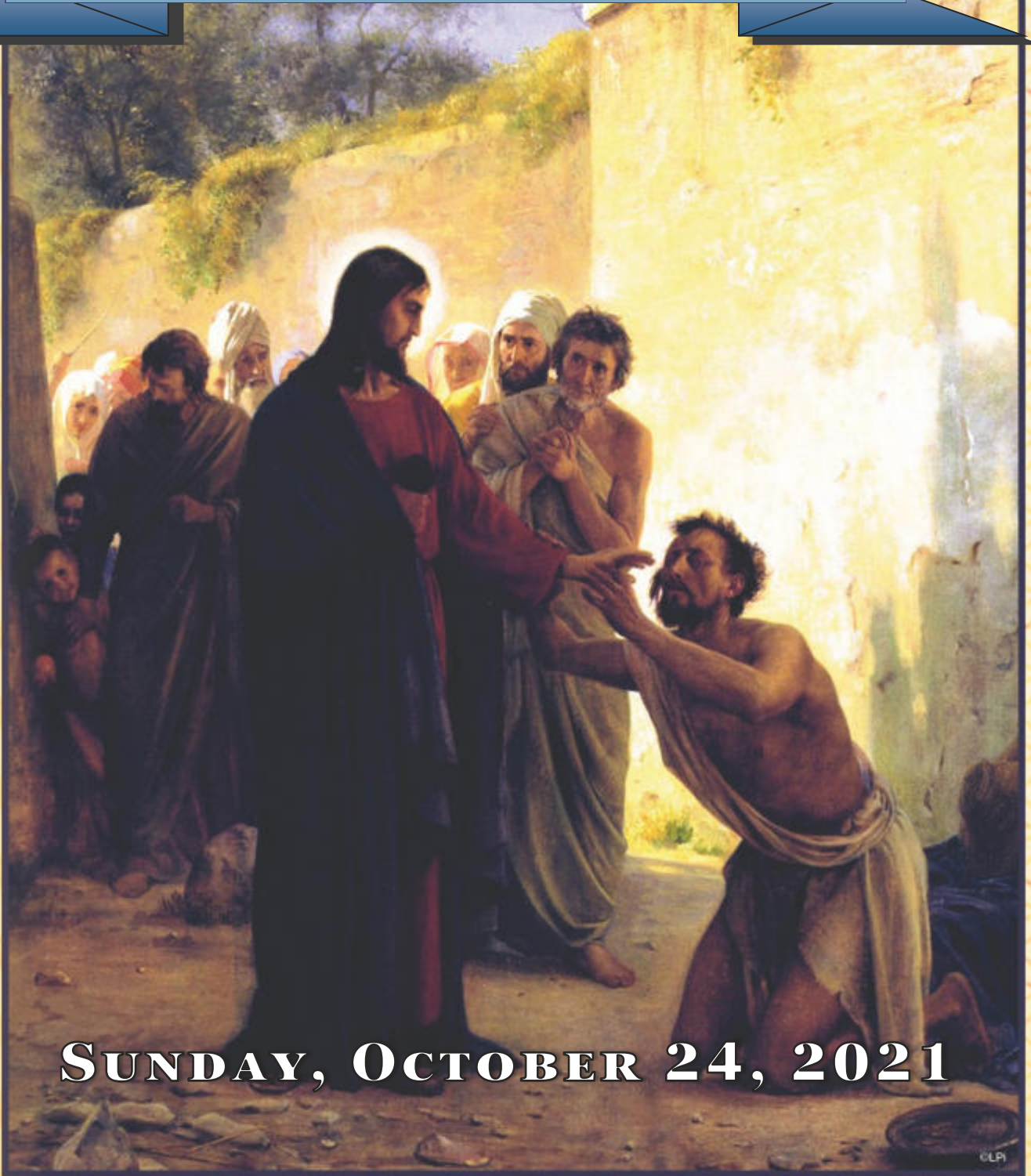

Just remember, we are the Body of Christ and the Lord's Mission has been entrusted to all of us.**

Why be an Altar Server?

Why should we serve? Because we're Catholics, and serving one another is our duty. To serve at the Altar is helping the priest, your parish family and above all God! Serving allows you to play an active part in parish life. You will be giving something very special to St. Peter's Parish.

What do Altar Servers do?

The main function of Altar Servers is to assist the Priest (and God) at the Altar. They do this in many ways, from lighting candles and holding the Roman Missal, to ringing the bells, carrying the Cross in the procession, and much more.



Who can be an Altar Server?

We are looking for both young parishioners and grown-ups. Students should be at least in the 4th grade and received their First Holy Communion. Adults have only one restriction: oxygen tanks are prohibited due to the lit candles in the Sanctuary! 😊 Other than that, we need Altar Servers who will always be on time, neat in their appearance and reverent in God's Sanctuary.
