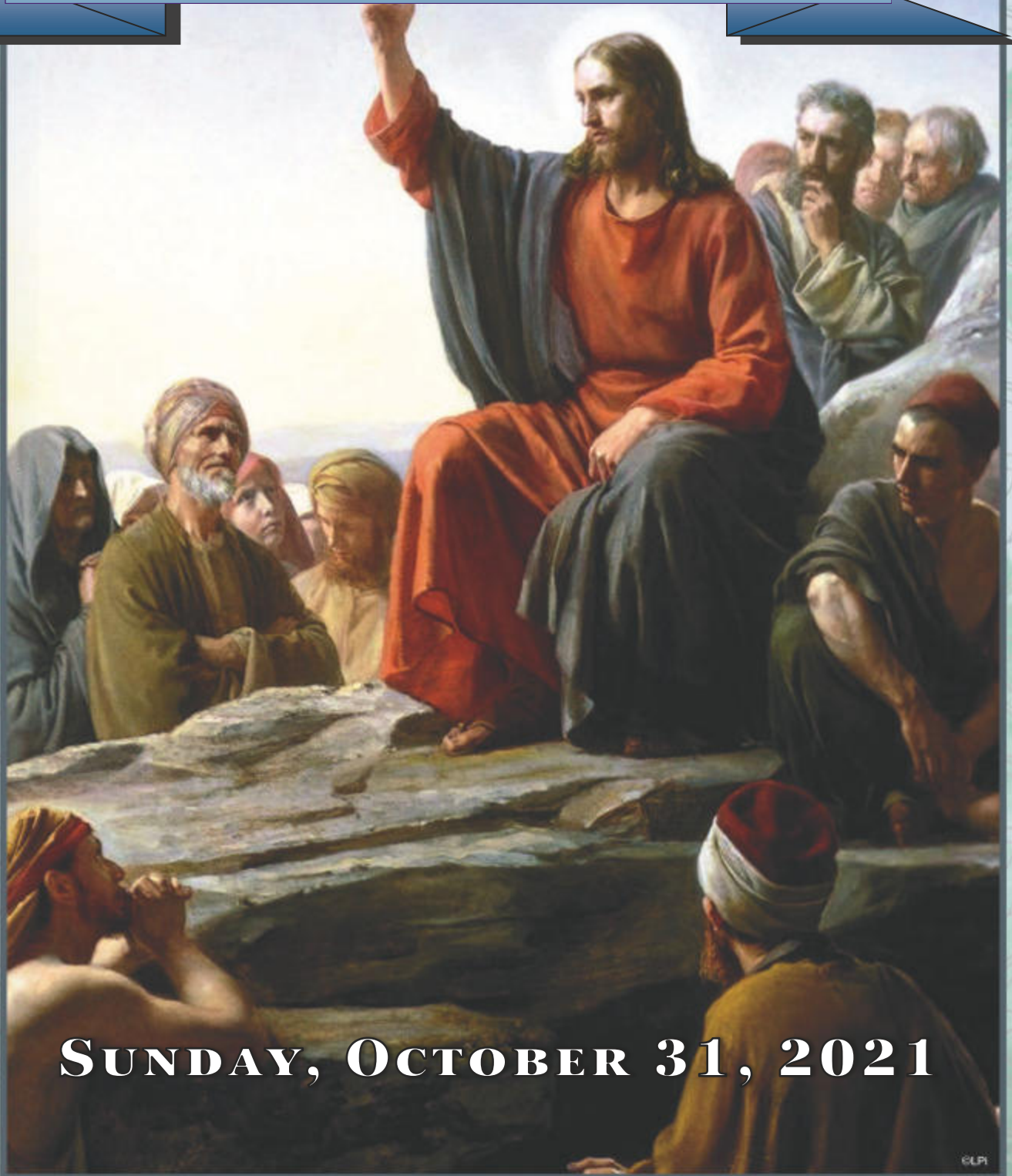

The word synod actually means “walking together.” It indicates a way of being Church that will help us make decisions together, decisions that will help us face the challenges of life in the 21st century.

Through the end of January 2022, dioceses around the world will be consulting members by means of questionnaires, online and in-person discussion groups and social media, on their experience of the decision-making processes within the Church and how we are working together to achieve our mission.
