Seasoned parishioners are appreciative that our pastor talks about Financial Stewardship only once a year and his timing always coincides with our bishop's annual Diocesan Appeal. It is an important appeal because not only is Stewardship biblical, but like so many Catholics throughout Northern Illinois, we, right here in Spring Grove, utilize many of the diocesan ministries which this appeal supports.

The response of our parishioners has always been generous, one of the best in the diocese! All money we give, over and above the target amount, is returned to St. Peter's and allows Fr. Joe the comfort of never asking us for additional funds to pay for major repairs, utilities or rising maintenance costs. However, if we were unable to meet our target amount, money would need to be withdrawn from our parish savings to make up the difference. This year, our parish family needs to raise \$49,218.

Father Joe is particularly sensitive to inflationary costs that are already straining our parishioners' wallets. He insists that we take care of our families first, and he will make sure that our St. Peter's family continues to live within its' means, too. Together, we can do this!


