

- The Eucharist is always to be received and never taken. Hold out your hand as if you truly know that it is God, whom you're about to receive, and that you desire nothing more.
- After the priest says, "Body of Christ," the proper response is "Amen." You need not substitute anything else.
- With your hands held out, wait to receive the Host.
 Do Not grab the Eucharist, but wait for the priest or minister to place the Host on the palm of your hand.
- NEVER walk away with the Host! You would run the risk of being tackled by a zealous pastor. Instead, take one step to the side and consume it BEFORE returning to your pew.
- When receiving Communion on your tongue, open your mouth W I D E. Touching your wet tongue or saliva is gross and no one likes it. Nor should you bite down with your two front teeth. Doing so is not good for Jesus or Father's fingers.






