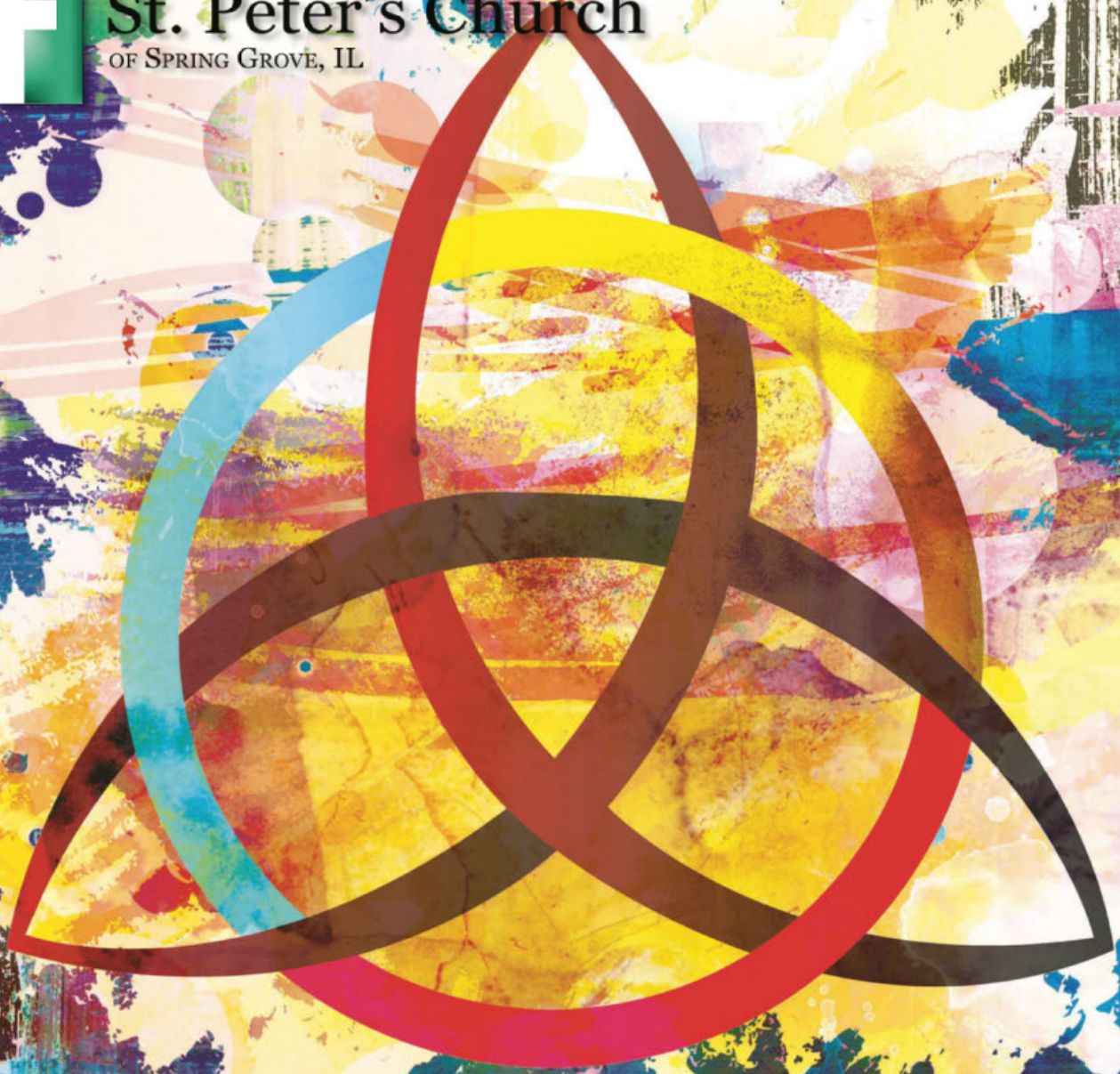

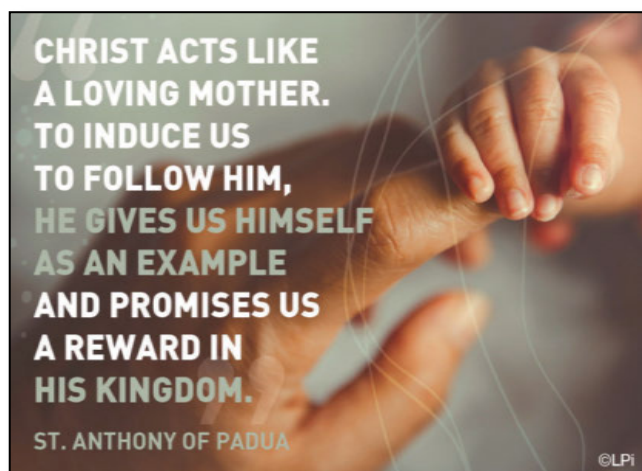

Two Jewish guys are walking past a Catholic Church when one notices a sign on the door that says *"Convert to Christianity, and we'll give you \$100."*

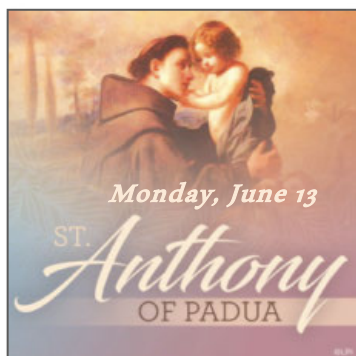
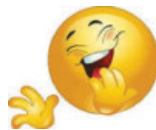
The one says to the other, *"Should we do it?"*

The friend asks, *"Well, did you get the money?"* He replies, *"Oh, that's all you people think about, isn't it!?"*

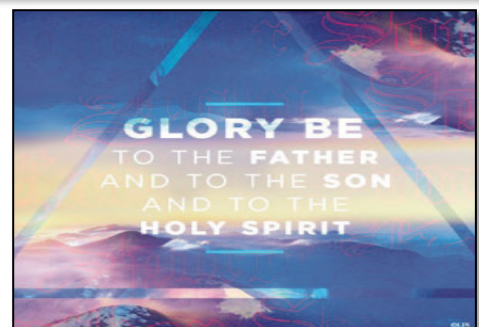
