COMING SOON

Repairs to the Shrine of our Lady of Fatima will begin soon! New statues, ordered nearly two years ago, have finally arrived from Demetz Studio, in Italy, but we need to remove the current statues first. This is a Herculean task because the statue of Mary is estimated to weigh a half ton! Thank goodness for Thelen Sand and Gravel, for coming to our rescue!

- Tim Tacheny, from Estate Lighting in Richmond, has already disconnected and removed the landscape lighting. He will reinstall the fixtures when the project is complete.
- Once Mary is removed, she will be safely transferred to her new home in McHenry.
- J-2 Concrete, in Johnsburg, will then create a new base and safely secure the new statue of our Lady. They will also secure statues of Lucia, Jacinto and Francisco, the children to whom our Lady appeared. Two statues of lambs are also included.
- Water Works, in Johnsburg, is making a gift to St. Peter's by converting our current sprinkling system, in the shrine, to a drip system. The new irrigation system will keep annual flowers alive without staining our statues with all the iron in our water.
- Do we have any good painters who will sand/grind the iron fence, repaint it and make it look like new? If so, please call the parish office to volunteer your time and talent!



Guidelines for Receiving Communion

On the inside back cover of our missalettes, parishioners and visitors will find guidelines for receiving Holy Communion in the Catholic Church. Catholics, for example, must be free from mortal sin and fast for one hour before ever receiving the Holy Eucharist. Should a serious sin have been committed, then, sacramental confession is required before

Catholics receive Communion.



And while we are always happy to welcome our brothers and sisters from other denominations to St. Peter's, let's not forget that the Church has always believed and taught that partaking of the Eucharist signifies a special unity among us. Unfortunately, the sad reality is that Catholics and Protestants are not one in faith, life or worship. We share a common baptism, but there are differences between us and the most important one is that Catholics believe the Eucharist is God. Our Protestant brothers and sisters do not, and therefore should refrain from receiving Communion at Mass. If you have questions, please call either Pope Francis or Bishop Malloy. 

A couple was celebrating their golden anniversary. Their domestic peace had long been known by everyone in town, and on this very special occasion, a local newspaper reporter paid them a visit.






