Who May Receive the Eucharist?

On the inside back cover of our missalettes, parishioners and visitors will find guidelines for receiving Holy Communion in the Catholic Church. Catholics, for example, must be free from mortal sin and fast for one hour before ever receiving the Holy Eucharist. Should a serious sin have been committed, then sacramental confession is required before Catholics receive Communion.



And while we are always happy to welcome our brothers and sisters from other denominations to St. Peter's, let's remember that the Church has always believed and taught that partaking of the Eucharist signifies a special unity among us. The sad reality, however, is that Catholics and Protestants are not one in faith, life or worship. While it's true that we share a common baptism, there are differences between us and the most important one is that Catholics believe the Eucharist is God. Our Protestant brothers and sisters do not. Therefore, they should refrain from receiving Communion at Catholic Mass. If you have questions, please call either Pope Francis or Bishop Malloy. If you are unable to reach them, you should call Msgr. Joe at the parish office.
