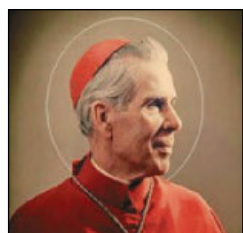

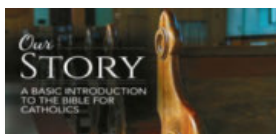

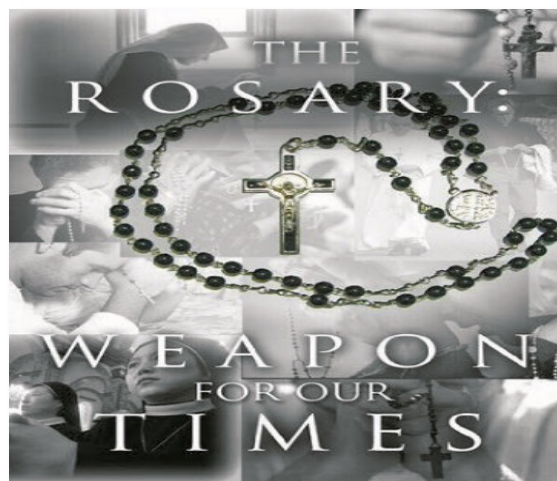

with the human touch, these blankets and shawls are created from the heart and filled with prayers and blessings for those who receive them.

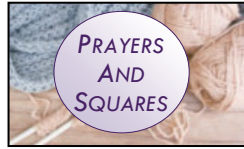
That being said we are in need of more yarn!

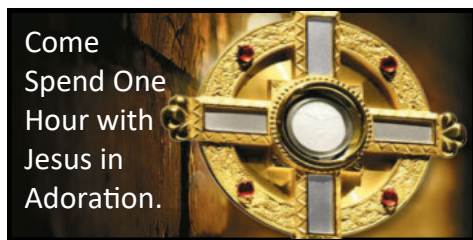
