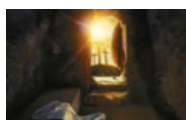

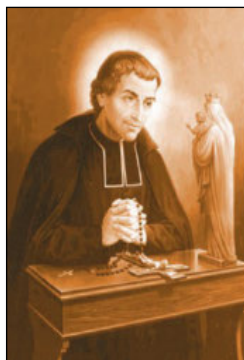
WINE AND DESSERT MIXER
