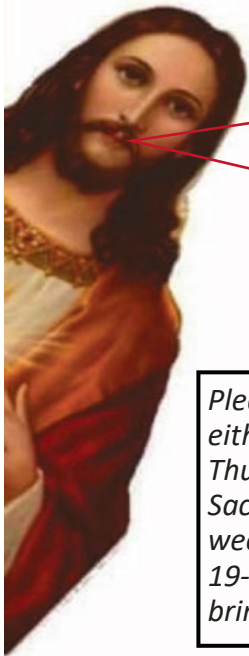

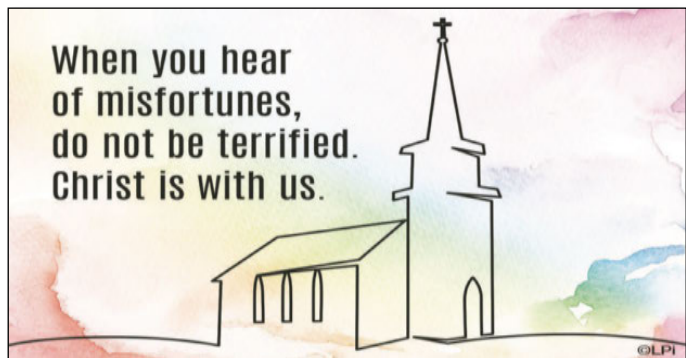

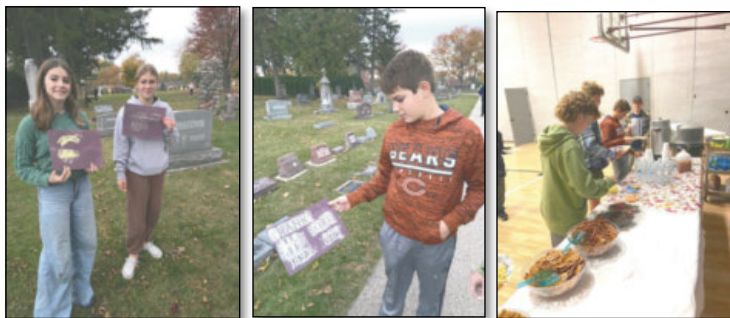

A well-known photographer was contracted to illustrate a book on church architecture, so he flew to San Francisco to begin taking pictures, with plans to work his way eastward.



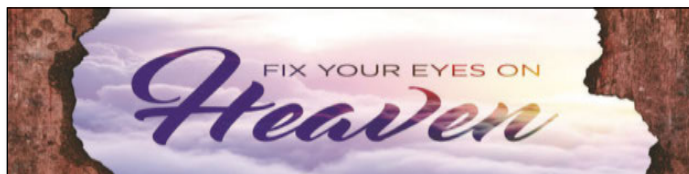
