

Jewel Osco & Helping Hands Food Pantry is asking for help to provide Thanksgiving Dinners


Fellow Parishioners,

A well-known photographer was contracted to illustrate a book on church architecture, so he flew to San Francisco to begin taking pictures, with plans to work his way eastward.




