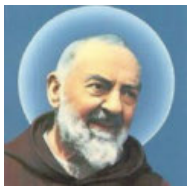

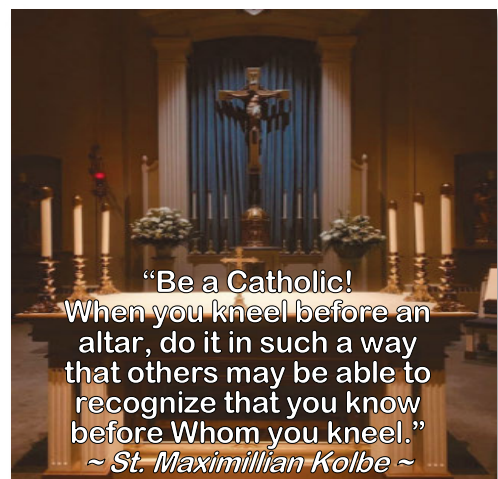

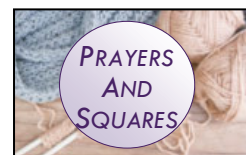
## Prayers and Squares Meeting

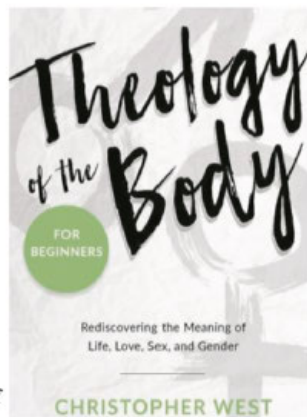
