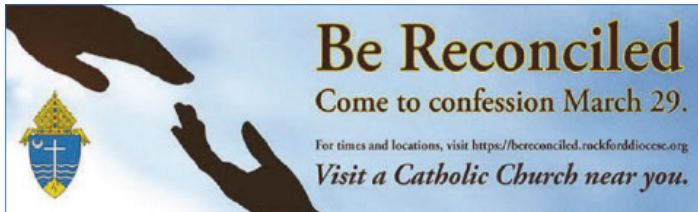

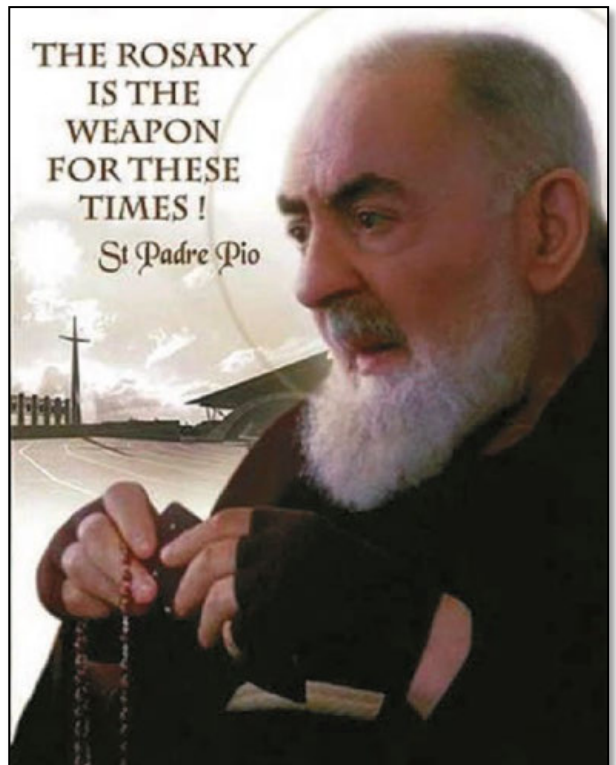

DON'T FORGET ON HOLY SATURDAY TO BRING YOUR EASTER BASKETS TO BE BLESSED!

In many Slavic countries, the tradition of blessing Easter foods has always been important to the community of believers. Many foods such as meat and milk products, including eggs, were forbidden during the Lenten fast and abstinence. But when the Feast of Easter brought the rigorous fast to an end these foods were again allowed on the table, many people showed their joy and gratitude by first taking the food to church for a blessing.

(PRACTICING) CATHOLIC

Offerings

Offer it up. My grandmother used this phrase with her children, and my mother, in turn, used it with me. It's a kind of verbal heirloom, a gift of wisdom from a generation that knew suffering all too well.

We know it to be true that God will work through our suffering if we invite him to. We know it and we have seen it — we have only to look at Lazarus and his sisters Martha and Mary.

But, often, I invite God into my suffering only to tell Him where I want Him to stand. I make an offering of suffering but expect God to do something very specific with it. *Teach me this, please. Give me this specific grace. Show me this specific answer.*

The happy ending in today's Gospel is not the alleviation of the sorrow Martha and Mary feel because it isn't alleviated, Lazarus is still human, and death still awaits him. Someday, his sisters will have to mourn at his tomb. That loss and pain will not be avoided.

The happy ending is that he is resurrected now, and in doing so, brings so many to belief. The happy ending is that Martha and Mary do not abandon discipleship because things didn't work out exactly the way that they wanted. They run out to meet Christ, eyes dim with tears. They fling themselves into his company and onto his providence.

They made an offering of their suffering, and their happy ending is that their offering was accepted.

How can I overcome the temptations of my life?

Jesus knows that the battle for holiness is challenging in a fallen world, so He gave St. Faustina Kowalska twenty-five strategies to help (*Divine Mercy in My Soul*, #1760).

Here is a sample:

"Do not bargain with any temptation; lock yourself immediately in My heart."

Don't assume you are strong enough for a "little" temptation. Run immediately to the refuge of Jesus' Sacred Heart for protection.

"Bear with yourself with great patience." Saints aren't made overnight. See yourself as God does – beloved. Be patient and keep trying.

"Do not neglect interior mortifications." Withhold a biting remark, give up a luxury for the day, cut down on screen time. Sacrifices for love are powerful.

"Shun murmurs like a plague." Gossip is never in God's service. False accusations and rumors that hurt reputations are Satan's favorite tools. Don't indulge.

"Always fight with the deep conviction that I am with you."

Our courage comes from being rooted in God (*John 15:5*). Recall God's loving presence throughout the day:

"Jesus, I trust in you!"

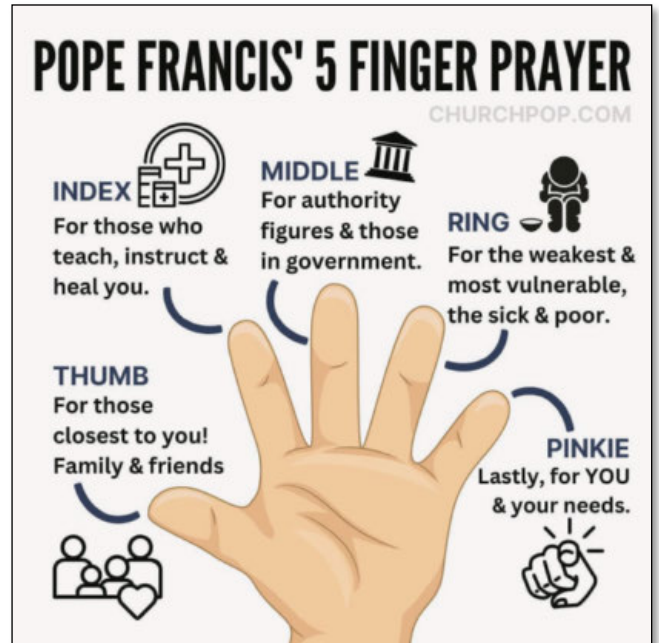

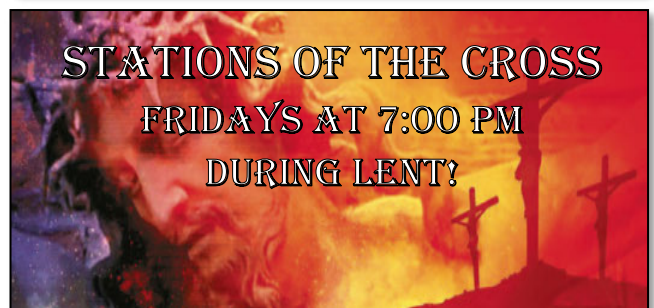
St. Peter said, "You need to understand how things are up here. We have thousands and thousands of priests, but you're the first congressman we ever had."

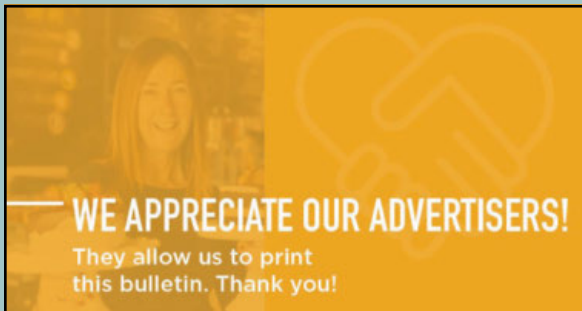

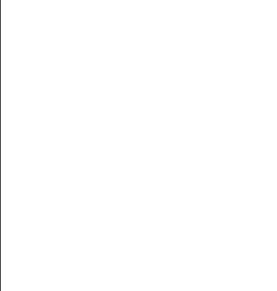
