LIVE THE LITURGY

INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

We are witnesses of all that Christ has done – in our lives, in our souls, in our hearts. We have seen the empty tomb. We have touched the abandoned burial cloths. “Go tell My brothers,” Jesus commands us. “Do not be afraid.”

Choose New Life at Easter

“... I have set before you life and death, blessing and curse; therefore choose life, that you and your descendants may live, loving the Lord your God, obeying his voice, and cleaving to him; for that means life to you and length of days...” (Deuteronomy 30:19-20)

When the Israelites were poised to enter the land God had promised them, Moses wanted all to understand what was at stake. He didn't want them to just enter the Promised Land, Moses wanted them to remain there with God's blessing. So Moses put the choice facing all of God's people in the clearest possible terms. **When we choose to follow God, we choose life over death.**

The choice is still ours. We can say “yes” or “no” to God's love. While our choices lead to consequences, it is still up to us.

When we live within God's laws, we choose life. Honesty over lies and deceit, self-control over sinful pleasure, generosity over selfishness. This is how we choose new life with God.



COMPLETE PARDON

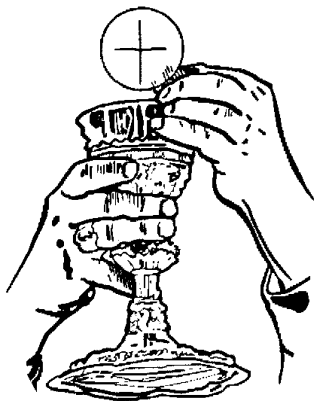
Next weekend is Divine Mercy Sunday and Jesus gave **Sr. Faustina Kowalska**; a message of mercy to be spread throughout the world. **“I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy.** Then He said to me, My daughter, fear nothing. I am always with you, even if it seems to you that I am not. Your humility draws Me down from My lofty throne, and I unite Myself closely with you” (Diary, 1109).

POWERFUL GIFTS OF EUCHARISTIC DEVOTION

As the *"source and summit of our faith,"* the Eucharist is the greatest of God's gifts. During the Easter season, resolve to look at the Eucharist with new eyes of gratitude and strengthened devotion:

Return love for Love:

The Eucharist is not a symbol; it is Jesus Christ. He loves us beyond imagining – personally, closely, sacrificially, and tenderly. In adoring, receiving, and loving the Blessed Sacrament, we're returning love for Love.



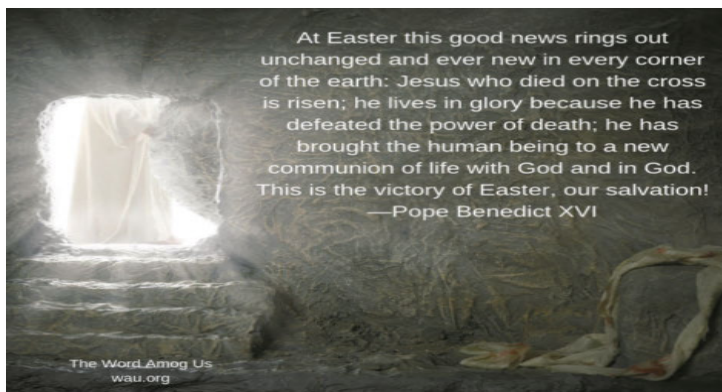
Fuel for the fight:

The Eucharist nourishes and strengthens our souls. *"How can we last... without hearing Jesus say, 'I love you' – impossible..."* (Mother Teresa). The Eucharist strengthens against temptations and protects from mortal sins.

Source of Joy: The Eucharist is a glimpse of Heaven, a foretaste of the heavenly banquet, and a pledge of future glory. St John Vianney commented, *"If we really understood the Mass, we would die of joy."*

Wisdom and guidance: As Chancellor of England, St. Thomas More; received Communion daily for *"light and wisdom"* in his administrative decisions. We can turn to the Blessed Sacrament for guidance whenever we have weighty decisions, questions, or doubts.

Communion empowers us to love: *"Even as I have loved you...you also love one another"* (John 13:34). Jesus specifically told His followers to love others as we've been loved. Receiving the Eucharist worthily empowers us to love like Him.



THE EASTER CELEBRATION

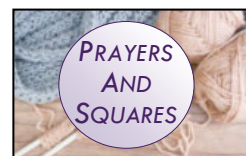
After Mass, many of us are swept up in a dizzying Easter timeline full of brightness and pastels, rushing from Mass to Easter egg hunts to lunch or dinner that may leave kids and adults alike exhausted. But our Easter celebrations and traditions are important because they mark this day as the most joyful of all celebrations, indeed the greatest event in human history. The Lord Jesus is calling us to new life in Him! We take this time to celebrate and reflect on what this means. After His resurrection, Jesus revealed Himself over time to His Apostles. But before they saw Jesus and truly understood He had risen from the dead, they experienced great sadness and fear. In the same way for us, we must remember that there is no Easter without the suffering and darkness of Good Friday. St. Paul tells us in the second reading that, in order to celebrate the feast, we must *"clear out the old yeast, so that [we] may become a fresh batch of dough."* We can't celebrate with *"the old yeast, the yeast of malice and wickedness"* – we must let Christ purify our hearts and fill them with His Truth.

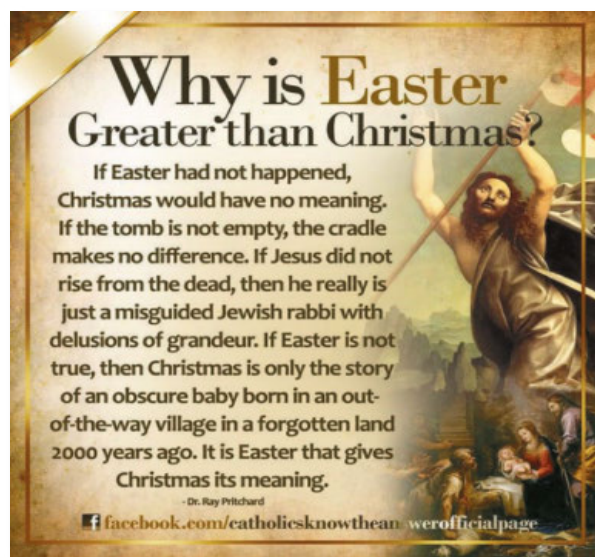

Easter Sunday and Object Permanence

When you play peekaboo with a very young baby who has not yet developed object permanence, you actually feel kind of mean. As soon as your hands obscure your face, their little eyes widen with alarm and their expression crumbles into confusion and despair.

Because they can no longer see you, they believe you no longer exist. Their little brains are unable to understand that just because a thing cannot be seen, it is still there, still alive, still full of love and care and protection.

Aw, man, you can hear them thinking. I guess I don't have a mom anymore.

On Easter morning, Mary Magdalene sees the burial cloth but no body. Her human mind makes sense of the situation the best way it knows how, she assumes the Lord has been taken. I'm sure I would have thought the same thing, in her position.

She cannot conceive, on her own, the reality that Christ has risen from the dead. It doesn't matter that he has told his disciples again and again that this will happen. They weren't ready to understand then.

In many ways, Easter is when the human race really achieved object permanence. But we still struggle with it, don't we? I certainly do. So often I can be heard accusing God: "You weren't there. Where were you? I couldn't find you."

But I looked for him in the flesh. I looked for him in the stale yeast of the world — in money or success or affirmation or (worst of all) convenience and pleasure. Of course, I would not find him there, among the dead.

Blessed Carlos Acutis (May 3, 1991-October 12, 2006)

- English-born, Italian Catholic youth
- Known for his cheerfulness, computer skills, and deep devotion to the Eucharist - core theme of his life.
- Amateur computer programmer who is best known for documenting Eucharistic Miracles around the world.
- He catalogued them into a website. It was completed in 2005, having started it at the age of 11 in 2002.
- His aim was to use the media to evangelize and proclaim the Gospel using social media. Unfortunately, Carlos died on October 12, 2006 from Leukemia at the age of 15.
- He was beatified by Pope Francis on October 10, 2020.

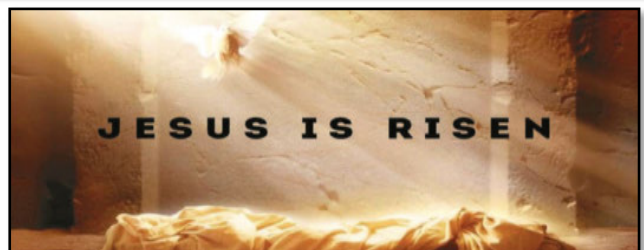
Exhibit Information

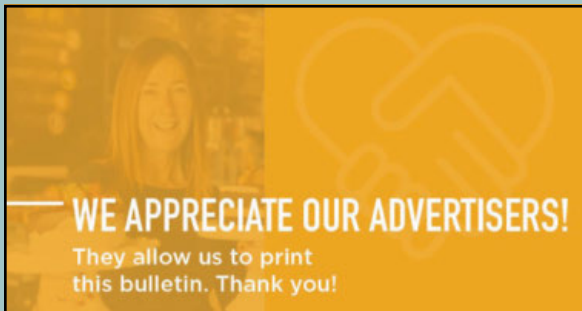
