



My name is Marie Lourdes Arnold. I hold an art degree in psychology from Roosevelt University and a master's from Loyola University in Pastoral Studies and Chaplaincy in Healthcare. I have more than five years as a hospital Chaplain at Aurora Condell Medical Center and Northwestern Medicine in McHenry, Huntley, and Woodstock. I am a trained Grief and Bereavement Facilitator



Talking with Fr. Joe, I understand there is a strong need for grief support in our parish. A group

support program involves meeting as a group one or two times per month. This program is for adults only and it will help you understand the many emotions associated with the loss of your loved one.

The Church's role here is to support those who grieve. For this reason, "those who are baptized into Christ and nourished at the same table of the Lord are responsible to one another." Thus, grief support allows the bereaved to experience the "Church" comforting, consoling, and supporting them.

There will be an informational meeting on June 8th, from 4:00 - 5:00 p.m. at the parish office. It will be an introduction to an 8 week program, and we will meet once a month beginning on June 15th.
