Friday, August 18th at 8:00 a.m.

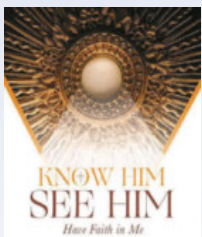

The Apostles' Creed series—part 3 (of 5)

This five-week series will break down the 12 articles of the Apostles' Creed, the essentials of our faith.

As the Church spread throughout the world, gaining many new followers, it required a common language to express the Church's beliefs. The Apostles' Creed was one aspect of a common language, allowing unification between Christians worldwide and ensuring all shared the same beliefs.

Article 5: He Descended Into Hell. The Third Day He Arose Again From the Dead.

"Hell" was a term used by early Christians to describe the place of the dead. While Jesus died and went to the place of the dead, this article goes on to state that He came back from the dead, due to His own divine power. He wasn't just dead for a few minutes; He was dead dead—and then He rose from the dead. More than a resuscitated corpse, Jesus returned from the dead in a risen and glorified body.

Article 6: He Ascended Into Heaven and Is Seated at the Right Hand of God the Father Almighty.

When the divine and human aspects of Jesus became united in the Incarnation, they would never be separated, and Christ ascended into Heaven. Following His Resurrection, Christ's human body will exist for all of eternity. Believers of the Catholic faith hope to join Jesus in Heaven one day, where He resides with His body and soul.

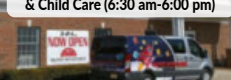
