
The 11:00 am Mass will be dedicated to the deceased Knights of our Parish.

Let us never make the grave mistake of assuming we earn our salvation in the same way we earn a wage. It is a gift lavished upon us by a God who does not count the hours of our labor or measure the amount of our output.



Do you know that the State of Illinois legislature has passed one law after another, trying to hinder or even shut down pregnancy centers like 1st Way in Johnsburg. Currently, 1st Way Life Center is represented by the Thomas


Moore Society in two separate lawsuits against the State of Illinois.

- SB 1564, passed in December 2016, requires pregnancy centers to speak about the advantages of abortion and to refer clients for abortions.
- SB 25 passed in June 2023, allows for fines up to \$50,000 on a pregnancy center if they are found to be misrepresenting in any way. The law is written very broadly so that misrepresenting can be interpreted that pregnancy centers have different opinions than the current culture.

Injunctions are in place, and 1st Way continues to stand for life! Last year, 61 women, who were abortion minded or abortion vulnerable were helped by 1st Way. Proactive interventions saved 17 lives, and thus far, in 2023, 6 mothers have definitely made choice for life! Medical professionals helped each client see her ultrasound image, hear her baby's heartbeat and offer to give her life saving options.

With the help of St. Peter's and other caring people, 1st Way served over 200 women this past year by providing diapers, formula, clothing and many useful baby items. And let's not forget the facilitation of child development classes, mentorship, and mom's support groups!

1st Way is grateful to St. Peter's Church for our support over the years, and they depend on us as they move forward. Everyone is cordially invited to enjoy a tour and refreshments at an Open House on Monday, October 16th, from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m., 3714 Fairview Ave. in Johnsburg.






