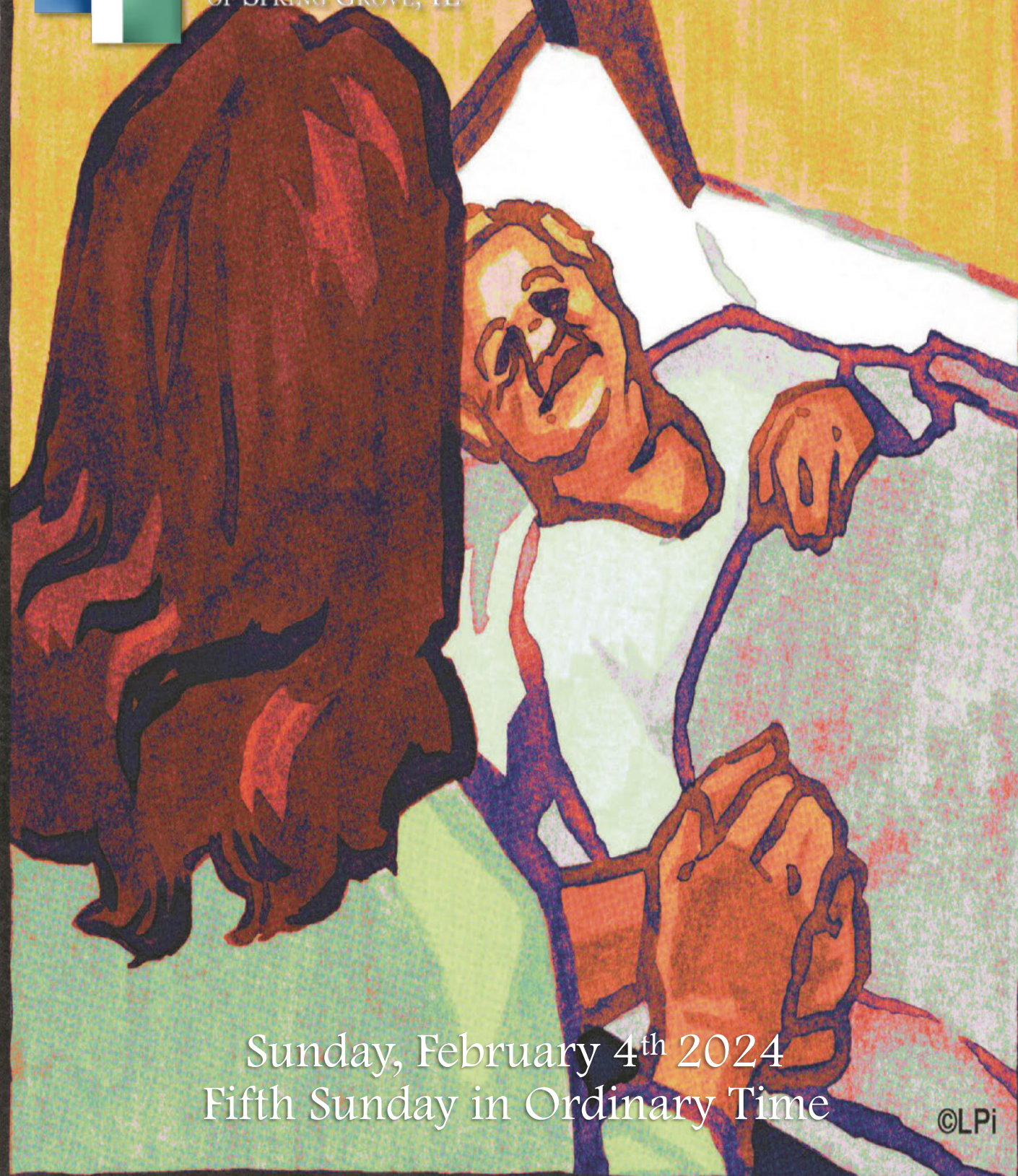

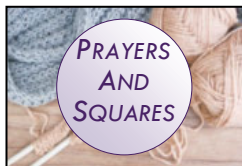

## Spaghetti Supper - January 27th

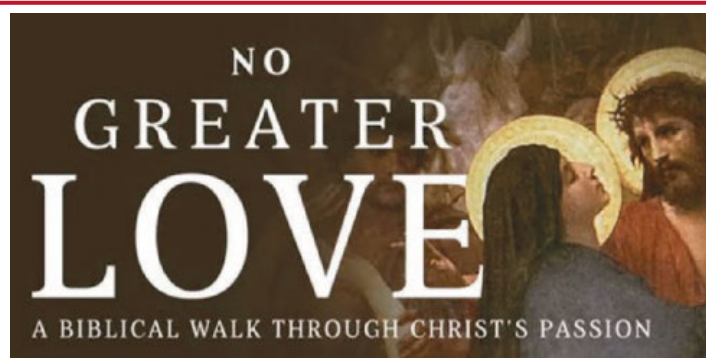
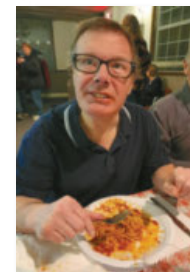
