



## **Lenten Almsgiving Banks**

As a community, our almsgiving this year will go to the Jack Brewer Foundation which provides orphan care, disaster and medical relief, missionary work and supports programs for fatherless youth. Everything the foundation does is aimed at following the commandments of our Lord. For more information, click on the video link on the front page of St. Peter's website. If you did not receive a bank on Ash Wednesday, simply ask an usher and they will be happy to give you one. Your bank can then be returned at the end of Lent.

The call to charity is a frequent theme of the Gospels, and during Lent, we are to be more focused on "almsgiving," which means donating to the poor and doing other acts of charity. The Lenten call to almsgiving means making the needs of other people our own. One of the central lessons of the cross is compassion; the heavy burdens we carry help us to appreciate the suffering in others. Suggestion: take what you would have spent on food during your Lenten fasting, and make that your almsgiving gift.

## (On the Cover – Continuation)

Christ Himself is luminous in the cloud, flanked by Moses to the left and Elijah to the right – symbols of the Law and the prophets.

The figures tell the story through their expressive gestures. Peter is almost prostrate in adoration, James's arms are raised in praise, and John rests in a pious bow. Zuccarei offers three versions here of what a person's natural response might be to such an amazing experience of the divine. Christ's own gesture is one of openness, and ascent. He is giving Himself fully to His Father with luminous and serene expression. Moses and Elijah are the steadiest figures of the scene – figures of heavenly transcendence breaking in to our reality with an otherworldly centeredness and poise.

As if to further emphasize the encounter between heaven and earth, Zuccarelli pays great attention to the natural landscape. The most important element is the cloud – a common element of nature, which here becomes the vehicle that both reveals and conceals a glimpse of heaven. The cloud is heavy, with darker edges on the outside, and it lightens toward the center. It has a dimensionality to it, as if its center is a portal, and opening that invites us into and everbrightening depth.


