




Congratulations to the New Officers of SPWM







Cover Painting ~ Pentecost - 1615-1620, Spanish School Fray Juan Bautista Maino

Juan Bautista Maino, had painted "Pentecost," for the high Altar of the Convent of the Barefoot Carmelites the Church of San Pedro Mártir in Toledo. Notice that Mary occupies the center of the composition with the Apostles on either side of her, six standing just behind her and six kneeling alongside or slightly in front of her. Mary is portrayed wearing a red tunic with her head covered by a veil and her cloak, as she is also seen in Maino's other compositions.

Also kneeling and closer to the viewer is Mary Magdalene, depicted here as a beautiful young woman dressed in a white tunic and gold-colored cloak. Magdalen is rendered as overtly sensual in type, due in part to her delicate garments and also to her radiant face, which is tilted upwards in a way that conveys profound emotion, a sentiment that is emphasized by the gesture of acceptance and acknowledgement of her hands.

The upper part of the canvas includes a large white dove seen frontally with its wings outstretched. It creates around itself a luminous burst of light that breaks up the intense darkness among which the heads of five cherubim are visible. The Dove of the Holy Spirit is the origin of the small tongues of fire that can be seen hovering over the heads of the figures depicted. All of them observe the miracle in a restraint manner.

Saint Peter is observed to the side of Mary, holding a text in his left hand while his right hand is extended above the Virgin's head, pointing at the presence of the Holy Spirit in a gesture that also visually helps to draw attention to the center of the composition. Maino used considerable variety in his depictions of the other Apostles, although they all conform to a humble social type.
