No matter what we do, the world will always have something to say. So, don't seek approval from the world. Seek to please God! Because if He is pleased with You, what does it matter what others think?



In the near future, our diocese will be conducting a major, capital campaign. And it was during the assessment phase, when parishioners throughout the diocese asked many insightful questions. In last weekend's bulletin, included some of those questions and the answers to them. In the spirit of transparency and communication, we are sharing even more questions that we asked, and the answers to them.

What are the parishes' responsibilities, and how will the diocese support them?

Every parish, under the leadership of the pastor, will:

- Assess their needs and determine which projects to promote
- Form a campaign team by soliciting the help of key volunteers
- Host campaign events
- Personally meet with parishioners to ask for their financial support

The diocese will support parishes by:

- · Covering the campaign fees
- Providing funding for administrative costs including designing, printing and mailing

Will the campaign impact offertory?


Offertory is expected to remain constant during the campaign's three-year pledge period. On many occasions, parishes have experienced noticeable increases in offertory giving in the years following the conclusion of a campaign.

Can you remind me of the results of the United in Faith Campaign that was conducted in 2001? What is the status of the funds now?

\$23.4 million was raised during the United in Faith Campaign for a restricted fund for long-term use for schools, seminarian/priest education, religious education/youth ministry, support for the needy and poor, and priest retirement. As of June 30, 2024, \$27.8 million as been distributed from this fund's earnings, which currently holds \$34.8 million for these specific uses. 
