Kindly remember that from Holy Thursday through Easter Sunday, Catholics do not celebrate funeral Masses. Should a loved one die, a funeral could be permitted outside of Mass. However, the Solemnity of the Triduum would be maintained and the following restrictions applied: there could be no music played, no singing, no accompaniment or Church bells. Please understand these restrictions are meant to preserve the primacy of these holiest days and no priest or bishop can make an exception to this practice.





#### Don't Forget On Holy Saturday to Bring Your Easter Baskets To Be Blessed!

The Slavic tradition of blessing Easter foods has always been important to communities of believers around the world.

Many foods such as meat and milk products, including eggs, are forbidden during the Lenten fast and abstinence. But the Feast of Easter the rigorous fasting was brought to an end, and these foods were again allowed on the table and many people showed their joy and gratitude by first taking the food to the Church for a blessing!

This wonderful Slavic tradition continues at St. Peter's! Beginning at 11:00 a.m. on Holy Saturday in the Parish Hall, Msgr. Joe will gladly bless everyone's Easter Baskets, filled with some of the foods and wines that you will be serving for Easter Dinner.

#### **Hosanna To The Messiah**

While Jesus would not be crowned an earthly king, Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem has many parallels to the Messianic expectations of the Hebrew people. Before entering, Jesus

requisitions a donkey from its owner. In the ancient world, kings had this right.



Yet the animal that Jesus requests is rare—a colt upon which no one else has sat yet. Yet, it's a donkey. This is no great war-charger, no magnificent animal. Jesus acts with all the authority of an earthly king, yet his kingdom is one of simplicity and peace. As the disciples throw cloaks over the donkey, the crowd spreads theirs on the road. This ancient gesture dates back to the line of kings descended from David. Not only are these physical kingly gestures, but the crowd of followers cries out in jubilation and praise.

The Messiah has come to Jerusalem!
