

- + Prepare by abstaining from food and drink (water and medicine excepted) for at least one hour before receiving Holy Communion.
- + Make an Act of Thanksgiving by taking time to prayerfully thank the Lord for all His blessings before leaving the church.



His prognosis was not good, but he decided to fight the cancer and he began 12 weeks of grueling chemotherapy. During the second week of treatment, Mark had an "experience" of God. God told him how difficult the road ahead would be, but assured him that He would be with him every step of the way, and this was a battle to be won. Following that experience, he wrote this prayer. In addition to his chemo treatments, complete with all the side effects, Mark would go on to have 6 surgeries, including 3 craniotomies. When Fr. Joe met him in the hospital, just last Friday, Mark received the news that he is cancer free and was going home the next day! No one will ever convince him that God doesn't hear our prayers and that He isn't closer than we can ever imagine! When fighting your own battles, feel free to make Mark's prayer your own.




