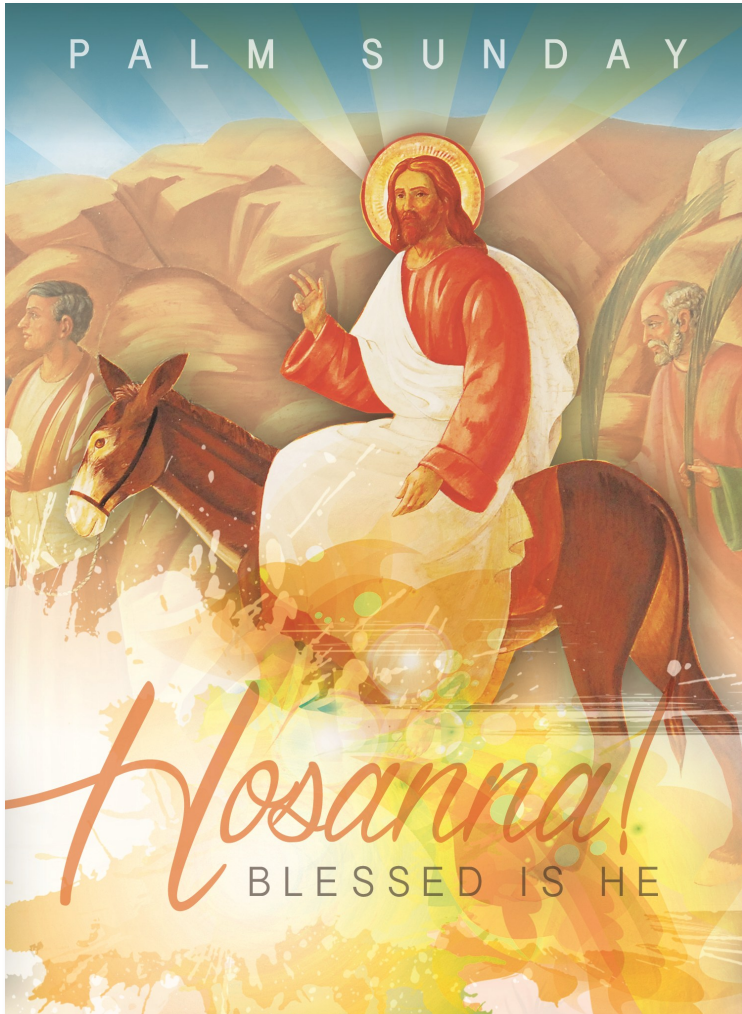

However, the Solemnity of the Triduum would be maintained and the following restrictions applied: there could be no music played, no singing, no accompaniment or Church bells. Please understand these restrictions are meant to preserve the primacy of these holiest days and no priest or bishop can make an exception to this practice.
