# The Unforgivable Sin

The 'Unforgivable Sin'? What Blasphemy Against the Holy Spirit Really Means?



Why does Jesus say in the Gospels that “whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit never has forgiveness, but is guilty of an eternal sin”?

The Church is crystal clear that there are “no limits to the mercy of God.” (CCC 1864)

***Jesus Christ died for everyone’s sins, and anyone who repents of his sins and follows Christ can receive forgiveness and new life.***

So then why does Jesus say in the Gospels that “whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit never has forgiveness, but is guilty of an eternal sin”? (Mark 3:29) Is this some sort of exception that we must be wary of?

**Yes, but not in the way you might expect. And here’s why.**

But first, let’s look at what Christ says exactly. Our Lord’s teaching on “blasphemy of the Holy Spirit” is recorded in all three of the Synoptic Gospels.

**In Mark, Jesus says:**

**“Truly, I say to you, all sins will be forgiven the children of man, and whatever blasphemies they utter, but whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit never has forgiveness, but is guilty of an eternal sin.” (Mark 3:28-29)**

**What is the sin against the Holy Spirit?**

**Thankfully, the *Catechism* addresses this teaching directly: “There are no limits to the mercy of God, but anyone who deliberately refuses to accept his mercy by repenting, rejects the forgiveness of his sins and the salvation offered by the Holy Spirit. Such hardness of heart can lead to final impenitence and eternal loss.” (CCC 1864)**

In other words, the *Catechism* says that “blasphemy of the Holy Spirit” is **rejecting the forgiveness of God all the way to the end of one’s life. It’s blasphemy of the Holy Spirit because salvation is offered to every person by the Holy Spirit.**

## HOW CAN THE CHURCH BE HOLY IF HER MEMBERS AREN'T?

First, Jesus was aware of the failures within religious life. In the Gospel of Matthew, He strongly rebuked the Pharisees—the religious leaders of His time—for not practicing what they taught (Matthew 23:3). Among His own disciples, there were moments of division, betrayal, and abandonment (John 6:66). Yet the redemption He offers is not reserved for the perfect, but for all who place their faith in Him.



Second, the Church’s holiness does not depend on the virtue of each individual member, but on the holiness of her Founder, Jesus Christ. A church building remains sacred even when its physical condition is imperfect because it is dedicated to God. In the same way, **the Church, as the Mystical Body of Christ, remains holy even as her members continue to struggle and grow.**

Third, history shows that God raises up saints precisely in times of difficulty. St. Athanasius, St. Catherine of Siena, and St. Thomas More each responded to periods of division and crisis with prayer, sacrifice, witness, and fidelity to the truth. Their example reminds us that holiness is always possible—and that we are called to live it, even now.

## Virtue of Obedience

### Obedience, Explained!

**Disobedience was humanity's original sin.** Conversely, obedience became the instrument of humanity's reconciliation to God.

Scripture calls man's submission of his own intellect and will to God, the author of revelation,

*"the obedience of faith."* (CCC 143) *"To obey in faith is to submit freely to the word that has been heard, because its truth is guaranteed by God, who is Truth itself,"* we read in the Catechism (CCC 144).

We see perfect obedience shown by Christ amidst his agony in the Garden of Gethsemane. His human will dreads what will come — *"My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from me"* — but his divine will, which is never at odds with his human will, submits to the Truth: *"Yet, not as I will, but as you will."* (Matthew 26:39). **Despite his fear, he embraces the divine will for man to be redeemed, and so we say that he was "obedient unto death."** (Philippians 2:8)

RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

### The Gift of Not Understanding

**Mini reflection:** Our failure to understand is not a poverty. It is a gift. It propels us constantly back to the wellspring of our glorious Faith—to Scripture, to Tradition, to the in-dwelling of the Holy Spirit which sustains each and every one of us who dare to believe.

I once listened to Bishop Daniel Flores—a renowned scholar and prelate—give a 70-minute talk on the Trinitarian nature of God. In those 70 minutes, Bishop Flores said a lot of eloquent things. But what really landed with me was not any group of words, but a single gesture.

Defining *hypostasis*, the term we use for the “*the reciprocal dynamic relations that constitute distinct identities within the Godhead*” (yes, I am using his words because I could never, in a million years, trust my own) Bishop Flores said “*the Father and the Son are true God, but the Father is not the Son, and the Son is not the Father. How not? Different hypostasis.*”

And here his eyes grew wide; he turned his head and opened his hands, drawing back as if from a spooked horse. The implication was clear: *Any further than this, I dare not go.*

I’ve never felt so seen.

Sometimes, I make the mistake of thinking that I am unique in my inability to understand the great mysteries. Sometimes, I despair that I am not a “*better Catholic*”—one who will rush headfirst into the crosshairs of a hard question, confident in the words that come immediately to my lips.

But when I saw Bishop Flores flinch at the thought of defining how, exactly, the Son is *not* the Father, and vice versa, I remembered that only fools rush in where angels fear to tread.

This Sunday, friends, take heart: our failure to understand is not a poverty. It is a gift. It propels us constantly back to the wellspring of our glorious Faith—to Scripture, to Tradition, to the in-dwelling of the Holy Spirit which sustains each and every one of us who dare to believe.

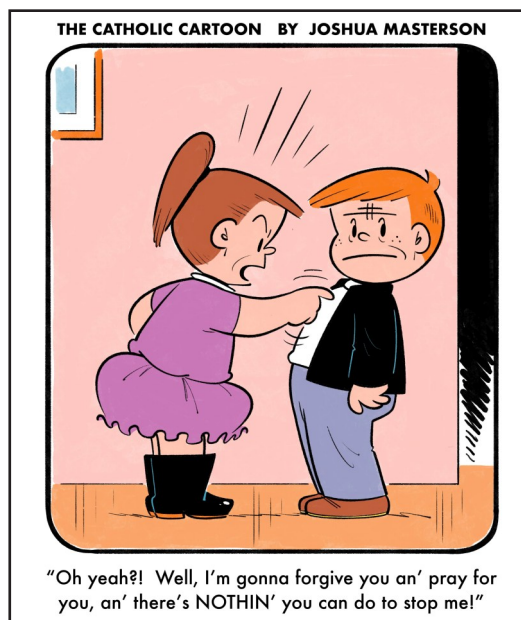
